Mike Attwood

Dr. John Lennox **Engaging with New Atheism Part Two: Does Christianity promote violence and evil?**

There will always be opportunities to share and support missions, ministries, missionaries and servants of the Lord, we just need to be willing to share.

Nancy Trogdon **Ladies Becoming Bible Students (W)**

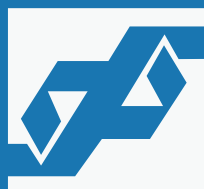
